Raising children who inspire

In his first year at high school in USA, a young man called Yash Gupta broke his glasses and had to go to school without them for about a week while a new pair were being made. He began to appreciate glasses and their impact on his education. Without glasses it was impossible to focus, see, or learn in the classroom, and after this incident he realized the importance they had on his own life. After some research, he learned that there were so many children who lacked a basic pair of glasses, even though millions of pairs were discarded annually. So he started an organisation called 'Sight Learning' a non-profit organisation with a single vision: 'To provide eyeglasses to students who need them but cannot afford them' Since 2010 they have distributed over 60,000 pairs of glasses to needy children, and all thanks to the concern of one young man for others.

How do we raise such inspiring children with a love and concern for others?

God wants us to bring up children who will do what is right and just (Genesis 18:19). Bible stories are helpful for teaching children, and also have vital lessons for all ages; learning about God (John 17:3), learning from good examples (John 13:15), learning from bad examples (Hebrews 4:11), learning to have wisdom (Psalm 119:99) and answering life's questions (Acts 16:30). My name is Jeffrey and I am 21 years old. I live in Castlereagh and I am one of the Christians who meet in Newtownbreda Gospel Hall. I am the youngest of five siblings. My mother has no particular Christian beliefs, but she sent us to Sunday school with the desire that we would learn to be 'good living'.

Each week, we learnt from the Bible about God. We heard about what he is like and the things that he has done. Above all, we were taught about his Son, the Lord Jesus. We learned how he came from heaven to be born as a human being; how he



showed compassion on all those met: healing the sick; delivering the oppressed; and forgiving the sinful – and I learned how he died on the cross, paying the penalty for my sin, so that I could be saved.

I remember realising for the first time that I personally was a sinner. One day, my mother found me tearful in the bathroom because I had done something wrong. She suggested that I should maybe stop going to Sunday school for a while and I was all too happy with that. The easiest thing in the world we can do when we realise our sin before God, is simply to ignore it, but I thank God that he didn't allow me to do that. My Sunday school teacher was soon calling to encourage me to come back again to Sunday school, and I obliged.

Sometime later, still only a young boy, I decided, at the side of my bed one night, to ask the Lord Jesus to forgive me for my sins, to save me from hell, and to let me into heaven. I believed that he would because God says, 'whoever calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved.'

After many years, I finally decided to obey the Lord I had trusted. I began to read my Bible and to pray more. I was baptised in 2013 and became a member of the Assembly of Christians meeting in Newtownbreda Gospel Hall.

Today, I'm still trusting him. I've found that life has many difficulties and it doesn't always turn out as I had thought. I know that I am still just a sinner. I don't always do or say what is right; and I don't always trust or love God as much as I should. But my life is in the hands of the great and good shepherd and every day I am understanding more how wonderful he is. I am learning to trust him and to find in him all my hope, all my peace, and all my joy.

One day an army from Syria came and made a raid on their village; she was taken captive and became maid to a woman who was married to the commander of the Syrian army. She was treated well by her new family but soon became aware that they had a great problem because the woman's husband, Naaman, although a great soldier, was a leper.

After considering the sorrow and worry that this brought to their whole family, one day she said to her mistress: "If only my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria! For he would heal him of his leprosy." The story shows what great influence a little girl who believes in God can have in the lives of others.

Have you ever stopped here, wondering "Is there anything coming?"



The Bible warns of coming judgement. You may not clearly see that it is coming, you may perhaps think that many people have been saying this for centuries but it hasn't happened yet! Listen to what the Bible says in 2 Peter ch.3

Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation." (v3-4)



Wonders of Creation Pollen



As you walk across a field on a summer day and see bees buzzing here and there or butterflies flapping, do you ever wonder what they are up to? This apparently meaningless activity is part of a process known as pollination.

Pollination is a very important part of the life cycle of plants and they cannot produce fruit or even seeds unless they are pollinated. Pollen is transferred by pollinators, which can be insects, the wind, or in a few other ways as well. To the last detail a flower is designed for the great purpose of reproducing after its kind. Colour, fragrance, form, the length and shape of each part all fit perfectly into that purpose.

Every individual type of plant has its own uniquely shaped pollen. Pollen is so unique and unchanging that it can be used in a court of law to determine exactly where an item has been if it contains a certain pollen.
